
THE KEY OF D

Hello Core music folk, today were going to be looking at the key of D. Lots of singers love this key as its a full tone up from C, and so can give you a little bit of room if you have a wider range.


Key of D

- 1st D
- 2nd Em
- 3rd F#m
- 4th G
- 5th A
- 6th Bm
- 7th C#dim

So the major chords are going to be D,G and A the 1st 4th and 5th in the progression, and the rest are going to be minors.... we keep the F sharpened from the last key of G, and now also sharpen the 7th so the C becomes C#. And of course now we know the 6th Chord is the relative minor the Bm.



Also in this weeks video you will also see me using the A shape barre chords, learning these with the E shapes are such a fast track to learning the neck of the guitar. It's such a great thing to learn and also makes you see if you can master the shape, you can play any chord, in any position up the neck of the guitar.



So if you look at the A shape on the left, and the Am next to it you can see that if you learn the slight fingering changes for the major A to the A7, and the change from Am to Am7 then bring in the use of the barre with your first finger, as you move up the neck. you will be able to play any chord. The route note of the movable chord is on the A string so learning all notes on his string is really useful. Especially if you move up to the fifth fret, and play D as a barre chord .
