

## MICKEY HOWARD IMPROVERS GUITAR GROUP HANDOUT 3/6/2020

Hi there everyone, I hope you are all well and looking forward to playing some guitar.

Today I would like us to enjoy a song from a band called Stealers Wheel. You have most likely heard this song many times and probably sung along to it.


The chords are not difficult and you are familiar with them all except maybe the **A min 7**.

This is a cool chord to play as it is almost the same fingering as the **C chord** it is just one less fretted note.

So for the **A min7** chord we place...


**Finger 1** on the **B string** at the **1<sup>st</sup> Fret**.

**Finger 2** on the **D string** at the **2<sup>nd</sup> Fret**.



As you can see we do not play the **low E string** in this **Amin 7** chord but we do strum across all the other 5 strings.

The chords in this song are shown below.



All the chords in this song are played for one bar (4 beats) each time except for the **C** and **G** chords in the chorus's that are placed in brackets like this (C) (G). These chords last for half a bar (2 Beats) each only.

### THE STRUMMING PATTERN



This pattern is also straight forward. Down strokes on the beat and upstrokes on the offbeat, there is a slight accent on the upstrokes almost like a reggae rhythm.

DOWN **UP** DOWN **UP** DOWN **UP** DOWN **UP**.

There are 8 strums to a 4 beat bar, so lets give it a go.....
