

Core Arts Membership via Personalised Funding



What does a membership at Core Arts include?

- ★ **College environment with wide range of courses** – Flexible access to our timetable of over 70 sessions per week across arts, music, creative computing, gardening & sports; delivered by specialist tutors (please see our prospectus for full details).
- ★ **Specialist facilities** – State-of-the-art facilities for making art & music including two recording studios, a mac computer suite, printing press, ceramics kiln, and three on-site gardens for horticultural sessions.
- ★ **Individualised support & advice** – Ongoing, accessible 1-1 support from the Membership team to assist students with their creative development. Support to meet other goals outside of Core Arts i.e. access to employment or education.
- ★ **Progression** – Help for individuals to develop as artists and musicians; including opportunities to exhibit & perform at our regular music events, and art shows and dedicated sessions to support them to develop and promote an online presence. Access to an internal supported volunteering scheme.
- ★ **Access to Core Arts community** – Additional drop-in sessions throughout the week to promote connection and community, including 2 x choirs, drop-in computing sessions and a regular programme of trips and events.



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Referral Process & Funding Options

- ★ Referrals for placements can be made by a mental health clinician working with the client via our website: www.corearts.co.uk/eligibility-referrals (please select Option 3).
- ★ We accept funding for placements via Personal Health Budgets, Personal Budgets & Direct Payments. Please call us and we may be able to advise which route is more suitable for your client. Unfortunately, we are currently unable to accept self-funders.
- ★ Please note our service is designed for individuals with Mental health as their primary need; and therefore, our service is not suitable for individuals with moderate to severe learning disabilities. Referrals are also reviewed on a case-by-case basis with regard to risk.
- ★ Once referred, clients will be invited to a tour of the service. Once confirmation of the funding has been received, they will be offered a start date.

Membership costs

- ★ **1 day per week** (client will be able to choose 2 sessions on their chosen day): £95 (Quarterly cost £1235)
- ★ **1 session per week:** £55 (Quarterly cost £715)

We recommend an initial membership length of 6 months.

We are happy to accept members for 3 months where there is a commitment from the care team to reviewing and extending the membership if the client wishes to continue.
